#### **New Business:**

#### **Out of School Youth (OSY)**

Mellisa Leaming provided an update on the OSY program for PY 22-July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023. OSY team is set following staff turnover. More OSY are using the services available such as training in demand occupations, internships, work experience, and on-the-job training. Walk-ins to the office are increasing since Covid. OSY team has increased outreach at community partner sites which has increased the engagement of youth. More youth are enrolled than in the past five years. Deb Waymire shared an OSY Success Story that will be forwarded to the Committee. Kara Webb would like to schedule a meeting to connect career advisors and OSY team members to help students transition and make connections post high school.

#### Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) Program and School Updates

Terri Simons gave an update on JAG. We continue to have the multi-year program for juniors and seniors at Lafayette Jeff, McCutcheon, Twin Lakes, Kokomo, Logansport, and Peru High Schools with an alternative education program at Oakland Academy. During PY 22, there were 236 enrollments. Terri shared the anticipated enrollments for next year at each school A new JAG Specialist will be hired for Twin Lakes High School. If funding allows, the JAG program may expand to Maconaquah High School in Miami County and Benton Central High School in Benton County for the fall of 2024. Kara would like to connect the Career Advisors

with the JAG Specialist. Kara, Terri, and Ethan Groff will arrange a meeting. Deb Waymire added it looks encouraging for additional funding to add the additional JAG programs.

#### **Rural Healthcare Grant**

Deb Waymire reminded Committee members of the Rural Healthcare Grant funding available to help pay for training for certifications for individuals interested in direct patient care.

### Pre-Apprenticeship - Apprenticeship Building America (ABA) Grant

DWD was awarded the four-year Apprenticeship Building America (ABA) grant. Region 4 will be one of the regions receiving funding from the grant and part of the grant funds are for preapprenticeship programs and dual credit programs as part of a pre-apprenticeship. Gerry Vasquez is the Apprenticeship Coordinator for pre-apprenticeship. Region 4 has funding to support 43 pre-apprenticeships at \$500 each apprenticeship. Funding is available until May 15, 2026. A list of pre-apprenticeship programs will be sent to the Committee. Lafayette Career Academy currently has a carpenters union pre-apprenticeship program.

### **StarPlus Energy Grant**

Region 4 submitted a proposal for a USDOL funding opportunity to support training and new collaboration with the electric vehicle industry. The goal is to train 700 individuals to be successful at StarPlus Energy electric battery plant in Kokomo or in one of the tier one suppliers. It is a \$2 million, five-year grant to be awarded in October 2023. The grant will be able to serve youth over 17 years old and no longer enrolled in secondary school. Indiana is becoming very involved with the electric automotive industry with another EV battery plant to be built St Joesph County.
